



# COVID - 19 RULES & PROTOCOLS

River's Edge Golf Club is committed to the safety of both our patrons and staff. A number of precautionary measures have been put in place to ensure that everyone stays safe. Safety will rely on full cooperation of golfers and our team members from the time arrival to departure. We have implemented a number of enhanced safety measures at this time including:

- \* reducing the number of touch points & ensuring hand sanitizer is available at every potential touch point.
- \* training our team members on enhanced cleaning, disinfecting and sanitizing any rental equipment.
- \* requiring the cooperation of golfers through adherence to our policies and procedures

## IMPORTANT COURSE INFORMATION: (Updated May 10, 2021)

- 1) No league play or organized tournaments of any kind are permitted at this time.
- 2) At this time **all indoor facilities** at River's Edge will be locked and not accessible to the public with the exception of restrooms. There will be limited retail available outdoors along with food & beverage selections.
- 3) Based on River's Edge's interpretation of AHS regulations, effective Monday, May 10, Outdoor recreation (including golf) can only be performed by the following defined "group" or "groups" a) members of the same household, b) A single living alone and 2 close contacts, or c) Individuals.
- 4) Tee Times can be composed of multiple "groups" who follow these important rules:
  - a) Power carts may only be shared by a "group". Two people in a different "group" cannot share a power cart.
  - b) Player(s) sharing a tee time with a different "group" must maintain an enhanced **12 ft social distance** at all times while on the golf course or driving range.
  - c) Continuous putting is a requirement during this time for all golfers to maintain proper distancing. The player closest to the hole putts first and once his ball is holed, they can move a safe distance away and another player begins. No player is permitted to touch the flagsticks at any time.
  - d) No congregating on Tee Boxes. Only one player on the teebox is permitted at a time.
  - e) No golf equipment of any kind can be shared with other players.

## BEFORE YOUR ROUND:

- \* Check in and pay at our "outdoor pro shop" which is the small grey shack in between holes #1 & #10 tee.
- \* Players can obtain a power cart 45 minutes prior to their round if they wish to go to the driving range.
- \* Make sure you are not bringing any outside alcohol on the premises. Leave it in your vehicle.

## AFTER YOUR ROUND:

- \* Return power carts to the designated cart drop off area past the small grey shack. Leave keys in carts.
- \* Garbage and Recycling bins will be available in the designated cart drop off area, however please consider taking it home with you to minimize exposure.
- \* Please COMPLETELY empty your cart of all personal belongings, garbage & cans.

No outside alcohol is permitted on the River's Edge Property. We appreciate your understanding of all new protocols we have in place for our patrons physical and mental health. Any player not in compliance with these rules & protocols will be asked to leave the premises. River's Edge Golf Club is privately owned and is not governed by NAGA or any other outside "association".
